

## Announcement of Position Opening

The Department of Cognitive and Psychological Sciences, the Graduate School of Informatics at Nagoya University, Japan, is pleased to invite applicants with a strong background in social/cultural psychology for a full-time tenured Professor position.

1. Position title: Professor
2. Number of positions: One
3. Teaching obligations
  - (1) Graduate courses: Social Cognition, Seminar in Psychology, and other related classes.
  - (2) Undergraduate courses: Upper division classes including Social Psychology, Seminar in Social Psychology, Experimental Methods in Psychology, as well as lower-division classes including Introductory Psychology.
4. Qualifications

Applicants must have:

  - (1) a Ph.D. in psychology or in related fields of social sciences;
  - (2) an outstanding record of research in social cognition with a high expertise in empirical research regarding dynamic relations between human mind and social/cultural structure.
  - (3) strong background in diverse research methodologies including psychological experiments, social survey, and neuroscientific analyses.
  - (4) ability to teach classes indicated above at the undergraduate and graduate levels, and to supervise students toward their theses at Doctorate (Ph.D.), Master's (M.A.) and undergraduate (B.A.) levels;
  - (5) ability to achieve the missions of Nagoya University, such as establishing interdisciplinary and international research networks.
5. Documents to be submitted for application, using an electronic medium (e.g., USB memory stick)
  - (1) Curriculum vitae including records of education and employment, and lists of publications (peer-reviewed articles, conference proceedings, books, book chapters, academic presentations, and so forth), grants and awards, and community service.

- (2) Reprints of representative publications up to 5 items.
  - (3) Statements addressing future plans for research and teaching, in approximately 1,200 words.
  - (4) The names, affiliations, and contact information of two persons for reference.
