Applicants are required to hold a Ph.D. degree before the commencement of employment and have expertise and outstanding research achievements in formal logic, computational model, term rewriting, program verification, knowledge representation and reasoning, and related topics. They must be able to teach courses in the Department of Computing and Software Systems, the Graduate School of Informatics, and the Department of Computer Science, School of Informatics. Communication ability in Japanese and English sufficient for conducting the required work is also necessary.

- 7) Full names and contact details (with e-mail address) of two references.
- 8) Other supporting materials (paper citation counts, obtained research funds, awards, teaching experiences, industry-academic collaboration, international activities, academic society and social activities, etc., if the applicant would like to present).
